

Changing State of Refrigerants – Digest 2018-9

California Governor, signs the California Cooling Act

Background:

In January 2018, the Federal Court reversed portions of EPA SNAP rule 20 that prohibited the use of HCF's in new equipment. (See Digest 2018-1)

In June the California Air Resource Board proposed regulations that would re-establish the vacated EPA SNAP regulations.

On 9-13-18 the Cooling Act was signed into law.

What this means?

A time new table has been established to remove selected HFC's from various enduses on California including; Aerosols, Blowing Agents, and Refrigeration.

This summary will address Refrigeration uses only.

New Equip. Ban: Under 2,200 BTU's - Non Flooded 1-1-2019, Flooded 1-1-2020 R404A, R407A-F, R410A, R417A, R421A-B, R422A-D, R424A, R426A, R428A, R434A, R437A, R438A, R507

Retail Food Refrigeration Equipment – All:

New Equipment/System ban 1-1-2021

R404A, R407A-F, R410A, R417A, R421A-B, R422A-D, R424A, R426A, R428A, R434A, R437A, R438A, R507
